GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION
SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

****ALL CRITERIA MUST BE MET TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP****

SUPERINTENDENTS' AND PASTORS' WIVES SCHOLARSHIP

- ◇ Must be a C.O.G.I.C. member of Historical Louisiana 1st Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction
- ◇ Must be a high school graduating senior
- ◇ Must exhibit academic achievement indicated by a cumulative **GPA of 3.0 or higher** on a 4.0 scale
- ◇ Must be involved in the Local Church (and/or) District (*see application for more details*)
- ◇ 2 Letters of Recommendation (see CRITERIA ESSENTIALS)
- ◇ Must attend **March Workers Meeting or USAC.** (*see application for more details*)
- ◇ Must type an essay on the life of **"Bishop Charles Harrison Mason"** and explain what impact his legacy has HAD on the Church of God in Christ and the influence it has on your spiritual life.
- ◇ Copy of acceptance letter from the University you plan to complete your undergraduate academic studies (the check will be sent to the institution)

A COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET MUST INCLUDE: (checklist)

(everything emailed must be in one email message and everything mailed must be in one envelope)

- ⇒ **AN OFFICIAL COPY** of the high school transcript as of APRIL (current graduation year) including cumulative GPA with **OFFICIAL school seal.** -mail-in only-
- ⇒ Bishop C.H. Mason Essay (Typed 250 word minimum) -email AND mail-in-
- ⇒ Completed Scholarship Application -email AND mail-in-
- ⇒ Indication of good standing with your Local Church & District -email AND mail-in-
- ⇒ 2 Letters of recommendation (sealed in an envelope inside the manila envelope) -mail-in only-

- Two (2) SIGNED letters of recommendation: (Pastor's, Pastor's Wife, Superintendent, Superintendent's Wife, and/or Church/District Leader)

-Please use the checklist below to ensure you have thoroughly provided the requested information.
 - Highlight the applicant's strengths
 - Provide insight into the applicant's character and potential to thrive academically
 - Verify the applicant's commitment to the local church and/or involvement in the district (name of events, auxiliaries, and duties/responsibilities)
